The former Mansion Inn has laid abandoned for half a decade. Before the walls are torn down to make way for the future, it will be transformed by local Sacramento students who will breathe new life into it with their art. From visual art installations in the hotel rooms, to live music, dance and theatrical performances at the outdoor festival, to a communal art piece that will be a centerpiece of the new hotel - we invite the Sacramento community to explore the answers to humanity's most pressing questions in a public celebration of the power of art to bridge the divide.

All proceeds benefit the Sacramento Arts Education Consortium, a new initiative of the Office of the Mayor, SMAC, Friends of SMAC and the Sacramento County Office of Education and all 13 local school districts.

### **About the Student Ambassador Program**

The Tearing Walls Apart Team is looking for 10-12 high school student leaders from the Greater Sacramento Area to serve as Student Ambassadors for the event. The Ambassadors will collectively be tasked with two main projects:

1. Creating short films highlighting selected Student Artists
2. Devise a Communal Art Project that will travel to local events across Sacramento

Ideal applicants are creative, collaborative, proven leaders who believe in the power of art and are excited about working with students from a variety of schools and backgrounds. Students should have an appreciation for art but do not need to consider themselves artists to serve.

Student Ambassadors are encouraged to apply to participate as Student Artists by separate application (opens August 1). Ambassadors that apply to be Artists will be given priority in the review process however are not guaranteed acceptance.
